Under these circumstances, you will be refunded in full and the seat will be offered to another student on the waiting list. We appreciate your understanding on this matter.

Return 10.30pm approx. (Please ensure you have made arrangements for your child to get home safely)

Cost: £29.30

There will be plenty to see, do and buy at Thorpe Park, so students may like to bring some spending money. They will also require enough food and drink to last them the day & evening or money to purchase refreshments at Thorpe Park. Students will be required to wear sensible clothing and footwear. Please dress appropriate for the weather conditions.

The total cost for the trip is **£29.30** per student. Places are limited and will be on a first come first served basis. Please book promptly to avoid disappointment this is always a popular trip and places do get booked quickly.

Once the trip is full we will operate a waiting list. If you wish for your child to be added to the waiting list please contact the school.

Please note Fright Night attractions are an intense experience.

As with any school trip, please be sure of your son's/daughter's commitment to take part in this trip before confirming their place. If in exceptional circumstance they have to withdraw we would try to transfer the place to another student, in which case you would then have some of your money returned (excluding any deposit or costs) and will not have to fully pay for the trip but this is not guaranteed.
